Dear Parents and Carers

Our Lady of Lebanon Parish Harris Park

On Saturday 18 July, NSW Health made a public notification that a parishioner from Our Lady of Lebanon Parish Harris Park had tested positive for COVID-19. The parishioner attended the Church on Wednesday 15 July at 5.30pm, Thursday 16 July at 6.00pm and Friday 17 July at 1.30pm and 6.00pm.

The Church will be closed until at least Tuesday 21 July during which time it will be deep cleaned.

NSW Health is advising anyone who attended Our Lady of Lebanon Co-Cathedral since Wednesday 15 July 2020, and is showing any [symptoms of COVID-19](#) to get tested as soon as possible. Testing clinics are available at a number of sites across Sydney including Westmead Children's Hospital. You can find a full list of the clinics [here](#).

Areas in Sydney & Victoria

Undoubtedly you would have been following the media coverage of areas of COVID outbreaks in both Sydney and Victoria. Just a reminder that if you have travelled to Victoria during the holiday break or have been at any of the listed Sydney areas at the relevant times (see [NSW Health information](#)). NSW health has directed that you isolate for 14 days from your return even if you have returned a negative COVID test.

As always the advice from NSW Health remains that anyone displaying any flu-like symptoms should not attend school and should get tested.

Please notify the school should your family be required to self isolate.
